Seahawks SUPER BOWL CHAMPS !!! Seahawks defeat Broncos, 43-8, to win Super Bowl Seahawks victory parade to be held Wednesday in Seattle

12TH Man will be out in force to celebrate the Seahawks return as the Super Bowl World Champions !!!

The Seahawks won their first Super Bowl crown by punishing Peyton Manning and the Denver Broncos 43-8. That masterful defense, the NFL's stingiest, never let the five-time MVP get going, disarming the highest-scoring offense in league history.

The City of Seattle announced a Victory parade is planned in downtown Seattle on Wednesday, Feb. 5th 11a.m. – 1:30 p.m.

The parade will start on 4th Avenue south of Denny Way and will end at CenturyLink Field
